NOT SURE WHAT LOCAL COUNCILS DO? READ BELOW FOR A BRIEF DESCRIPTION FROM NALC (NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF LOCAL COUNCILS):

LOCAL COUNCIL IS A UNIVERSAL TERM FOR COMMUNITY, VILLAGE, NEIGHBOURHOOD, PARISH AND TOWN COUNCILS. THEY ARE THE FIRST TIER OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND ARE STATUTORY BODIES. THEY SERVE COMMUNITIES AND ARE ELECTED BY RESIDENTS. THEY CAN RAISE THEIR OWN PRECEPT (A FORM OF COUNCIL TAX). THERE ARE 10,000 LOCAL COUNCILS IN ENGLAND AND 120,000 COUNCILLORS WHO SERVE ON THESE LOCAL COUNCILS

CRIME AWARENESS

KEEPING YOU AND YOUR VEHICLE SAFE

FOLLOWING REPORTS OF VEHICLE THEFTS THROUGHOUT THE VILLAGE, THE PARISH COUNCIL WOULD LIKE TO MAKE RESIDENTS AWARE OF ADVICE POSTED BY SOUTH YORKSHIRE POLICE (SYP) ON KEEPING THEMSELVES AND THEIR VEHICLES SAFE AND SECURE:

1. LOCK YOUR VEHICLE

- 2. KEEP THE KEYS SAFE (IN A POUCH IF IT'S A KEYLESS FOB)
- 3. BE AWARE OF CARJACKERS
- 4. PARK RESPONSIBLY IN WELL-LIT AREAS
- 5. WATCH FOR ILLEGAL TOW TRUCKS
- 6. FIT GOOD IN-CAR SECURITY LOCKS

7. DOUBLE-CHECK ELECTRONIC LOCKING

- 8. BEFORE OWNING, CHECK FOR CLONING
- 9. SECURE YOUR ENGINE MANAGEMENT DIAGNOSTIC PORT (IF YOUR CAR HAS ONE)

THE IMPORTANCE OF REPORTING CRIME

UNFORTUNATELY, WHEN CRIME HAS OCCURRED OR IS BEING WITNESSED IN PROGRESS, THE INCIDENTS THEMSELVES CAN BE OFTEN UNDER-REPORTED. WHILE INCIDENTS MAY BE DISCUSSED ON SOCIAL MEDIA, IT IS EASY TO ASSUME THAT SOMEBODY, SOMEWHERE HAS ALREADY CALLED THE POLICE AND NOTIFIED THEM, AND THIS ASSUMPTION -CALLED THE BYSTANDER EFFECT - LEADS TO AN UNDER-REPORTING OF CRIME.

THUS IT IS IMPORTANT, EVEN IF PEOPLE BELIEVE THAT EITHER A CRIME HAS BEEN REPORTED, OR THAT THERE ARE MANY WITNESSES, TO NONETHELESS PICK UP THE PHONE AND GIVE THE POLICE ANY INFORMATION THAT MAY HELP THEM DO THEIR JOB.

THE SOUTH YORKSHIRE MAYORAL COMBINED AUTHORITY (SYMCA), IN WORKING WITH SOUTH YORKSHIRE POLICE (SYP), IN ITS POLICE AND CRIME PLAN 2025 - 2029 HAS HIGHLIGHTED THE IMPORTANCE OF ENSURING THAT THE REPORTING OF CRIME IS AS EASY AS POSSIBLE, AND ACKNOWLEDGES THAT EFFECTIVE POLICING REQUIRES PUBLIC ENGAGEMENT AND SUPPORT, AND HAS COMMITTED TO TAKING STEPS TO MAKE SURE THOSE WHO DO REPORT CRIME ARE KEPT INFORMED AND UPDATED.

SPEED AWARENESS

- DID YOU KNOW WOODSETTS HAS THREE TRAFFIC MONITORING STATIONS?
- DID YOU KNOW WOODSETTS PARISH COUNCIL ROUTINELY ANALYSES THE DATA?
- WOULD IT SURPRISE YOU THAT THE MAIN ROAD THROUGH THE VILLAGE IN A TYPICAL MONTH SEES IN EXCESS OF 90,000 VEHICLE MOVEMENTS IN EACH DIRECTION? THIS IS LESS ON GILDINGWELLS ROAD WHERE THE THIRD STATION IS LOCATED
- ANALYSIS OF THE DATA RECORDED SHOWS IN A TYPICAL MONTH THAT AROUND 75% OF TRAFFIC IS OBEYING THE 30MPH SPEED LIMIT
- THIS SAME DATA ALSO SHOWS THEREFORE THAT AROUND 25% OF TRAFFIC IS TRAVELLING AT SPEEDS BETWEEN 35 MPH AND 55 MPH, IN OTHER WORDS 'BREAKING THE SPEED LIMIT', TOP SPEEDS OF UP TO 65 MPH HAVE BEEN RECORDED
- IN SIMPLE TERMS OVER 22,000 VEHICLES TRAVELLING IN EACH DIRECTION EVERY MONTH ARE EXCEEDING THE LEGAL SPEED LIMIT

DOG FOULING

THE PARISH COUNCIL HAS PURCHASED A 'DOG POO BAG' DISTRIBUTOR CABINET WHICH IS CURRENTLY SITUATED ON GILDINGWELLS ROAD.

DOG OWNERS APPEAR TO BE USING IT AND IT IS GOOD TO REPORT THAT THE INSTANCES OF OWNERS NOT PICKING UP AFTER THEIR DOGS HAS DECREASED.

THE CABINET IS MONITORED CLOSELY AND A SUPPLY OF NEW BAGS IS INSTALLED EACH TIME IT IS EMPTIED.

IT WILL BE MOVED TO VARIOUS PLACES AROUND THE VILLAGE AT INTERVALS SO IT IS IMPORTANT TO REMIND DOG OWNERS THAT ENSURING THAT YOU HAVE YOUR OWN SUPPLY OF BAGS BEFORE LEAVING HOME IS ALWAYS WISE.

A REMINDER THAT ALL FOOTPATHS ARE PUBLIC AND ARE COVERED BY THE SAME LAWS.

PAVILION REDEVELOPMENT

THE PARISH COUNCIL HAS ESTABLISHED A WORKING GROUP THAT HAS EXAMINED THE CONDITION OF THE CURRENT PAVILION BUILDING ON THE RECREATION GROUND SITE, AND HAS ASCERTAINED THAT IT IS CURRENTLY UNFIT FOR PURPOSE. THE WORKING GROUP ALSO HIGHLIGHTED ASPECTS FOR IMPROVEMENT AND WILL BE PUTTING TOGETHER AN UPDATED PLAN FOR ITS REDEVELOPMENT ONCE FURTHER CONSULTATION WITH THE ARCHITECT HAS OCCURRED, AND AFTER TAKING INTO ACCOUNT THE NEED FOR A PLAN THAT WILL OPTIMISE BUILDING AND MATERIAL COSTS, IN LINE WITH COMMENTS AND FEEDBACK FROM THE COMMUNITY.

SUCH A PROJECT WILL BE AMBITIOUS, BUT WILL SECURE THE FUTURE OF AN AMENITY THAT PROVIDES JOY TO THE VILLAGE, CATERS TO A RANGE OF AGE GROUPS, AND WILL HELP THE FACILITY PROVIDE A SERVICE TO CURRENT AND FUTURE RESIDENTS OF WOODSETTS.

THE PARISH COUNCIL HAS COME TO UNDERSTAND THAT THE AWAITED ROAD SAFETY SCHEME, SET TO BE ROLLED OUT BY ROTHERHAM METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL (RMBC), AND WILL INCLUDE THE IMPLEMENTATION OF SPEED HUMPS AND TRAFFIC CALMING MEASURES THROUGHOUT THE VILLAGE, IS STILL PROCEEDING DESPITE SOME DELAY

CURRENTLY, AT THE TIME OF WRITING, IT IS PROJECTED THAT THE SCHEME SHOULD BEGIN COMMENCEMENT AROUND Q2 2025
