It was agreed to arrange a site meeting with the residents, RMBC Highways, Parish Council and Lindrick Golf Club being asked to attend.

The new surfacing at Dinnington RD is breaking up in parts.

**8347 To consider the Children's Play Area**

£3432 has been received from the RMBC Councillor pot

It was resolved to purchase the Cone Climber play equipment to replace the swing at a cost of £8745 and to authorise the cost of removing the swing by a local contractor.

The cost of fencing from the car-park to the play area has been quoted at £9535.

It was **resolved** to approve the expenditure totalling £13,576.79

**8349 To consider speed signs in the Village.**

The 2 new signs in the village have been installed and the third is due to be installed in the next week.

Councillor Sherratt is still disappointed that the sign does not flash red.

It was resolved to put an article in the Newsletter about the signs and mention the fact that speeds are being monitored.

It was **resolved** to accept RMBC's quotation to mark the football pitch and manage the posts.
